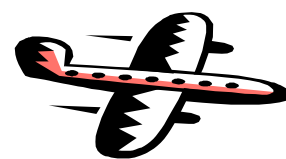


HANEDA AIRPORT (羽田空港)



From Yokosuka Chuo Station:

Buy a train ticket from Yokosuka Chuo Station to Hanedakuko Station (羽田空港) . Insert ¥790 and push the blue airplane marked button. This ticket is good for one way transit to the airport. Take a Red Kanji train (limited express called Tokkyu 特急) or a Green Kanji train (express called Kaitoku 快特) to Keikyu Kamata (京急蒲田) and get off at Keikyu Kamata.

* At Keikyu Kamata, go to Track 1 and transfer to the Kuko Line (空港線) bound for Hanedakuko which is the last station and get off there.

Schedule (direct train only)

● Weekdays

From Yokosuka Chuo Station to Hanedakuko Station: 05:08–05:52 / 05:50–06:40

From Hanedakuko Station to Yokosuka Chuo Station: 17:06–17:54 / 22:14–23:02 / 22:47–23:32

● Weekends & Japanese Holidays

From Yokosuka Chuo Station to Hanedakuko Station: 05:08 – 05:51 / 05:54 – 06:47

From Hanedakuko Station to Yokosuka Chuo Station: 22:17 – 23:00 / 22:41 – 23:32 / 23:04 – 23:55

From Jinmuji Station: (Ikego)

Buy a ticket from Jinmuji Station to Hanedakuko Station. Insert ¥690 and push the blue airplane marked button. Take a train to Kanazawa Hakkei, then transfer to a Red Kanji or Blue Kanji train to Keikyu Kamata and get off at Keikyu Kamata (Red Kanji train is faster). **Continue as above***.

NOTE: There will be English announcements along the way to remind you to get off at Keikyu Kamata. The Keikyu line has been expanded all the way to the airport, making the monorail unnecessary now.

*Alternate Way: Using Limousine service from Yokohama train station.

The Yokohama City Air Terminal (YCAT) limousine service will take you from Yokohama Train Station directly to Haneda airport. (YCAT Tel. 045-459-4800 English Information)

From Yokosuka Chuo Station, buy a ¥350 ticket. Take a Red or Green Kanji train to Yokohama station. The train ride will last about 25-30 minutes. *At Yokohama Station, head towards the East Exit (東口). Turn left out of the exit and walk straight. Follow signs to Sogo Department Store and YCAT Limousine Service. There are many signs in English to lead you.

From Jinmuji Station, buy a ¥300 ticket. Go to Kanazawa hakkei, then transfer train to a Red or Blue train to Yokohama Station (platform #3). **Continue as above***.

Fare is ¥540 for adults; ¥270 for children. The trip will take about 30 minutes to one hour depending on traffic. The first one departs at 0515 and the last one around 2200. It departs and averages every 10 minutes. Notice to Keikyu Railway Users:

Red Kanji trains only run during rush hour (effective 8/1/99)

Green Kanji train runs every 10 minutes from Yokosuka Chuo
