

LATEST IATA REGULATION :

The government of Japan has approved a rule issued by all the member of IATA concerning the penalties on returned discounted tickets.

IATA charge will be applied in addition to any penalty charges that may incur due to cancellation, if all returned tickets that need to be reissued or refunded. This rule has been in effect since 1 April 1999 and is not negotiable.

Penalty charge as follows (except Egypt air, Philippine air, Aeroflot Russian air, etc.) before departure

Cancellation fee ----- Y10,000. for per ticket.

AFRICA / MIDDLE EAST**

United Airlines ----- Y20,000. for adult, Y17,500. for child.

Continental Airlines --- AP 36 & 8 : Y20,000. for adult and child.

--- AP 1 : Y50,000. for adult and child.

All airlines except above --- Y17,500. for adult and child on IATA airlines.

- **HONG KONG / CHINA / TAIWAN / PHILIPPINE / GUAM / SAIPAN / SINGAPORE
THAILAND / MALAYSIA / INDIA / INDONESIA / PAKISTAN / RUSSIA / AUSTRALIA
NEW ZEALAND / SOUTH PACIFIC ISLAND**

----- Y10,000. for adult and child on IATA airlines.

- **KOREA**

----- Y6,000. for adult and child on IATA airlines.
